

## What a 67 Y-Chromosome Match Really Means

Genetic Distance	Relationship	Interpretation
0	Very Tightly Related	Common ancestor predicted, 50% of the time in 3 generations or less. 90% probability within 5 generations.
1 or 2	Tightly Related	Common ancestor well within the genealogical time frame <sup>1</sup>
3 or 4	Related	Likely to share a common ancestor within the genealogical time frame
5 or 6	Related	May share a common ancestor within the genealogical time frame
7	Probably Related	Possibly share a common ancestor within genealogical time frame
8 or 9	Only Possibly Related	Possible but unlikely that they share a common ancestor within the genealogical time frame
10 or 11	Not Related	Not related within the genealogical time frame

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The <u>genealogical time frame</u> is defined as the most recent one to fifteen generations. Recent genealogical times is defined as the last one to five generations.
