

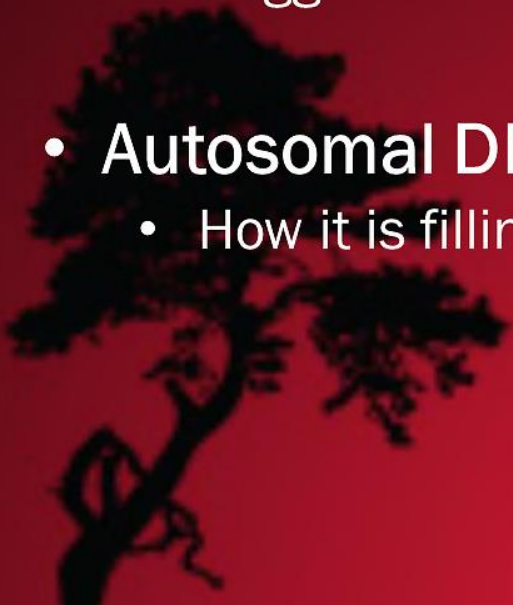

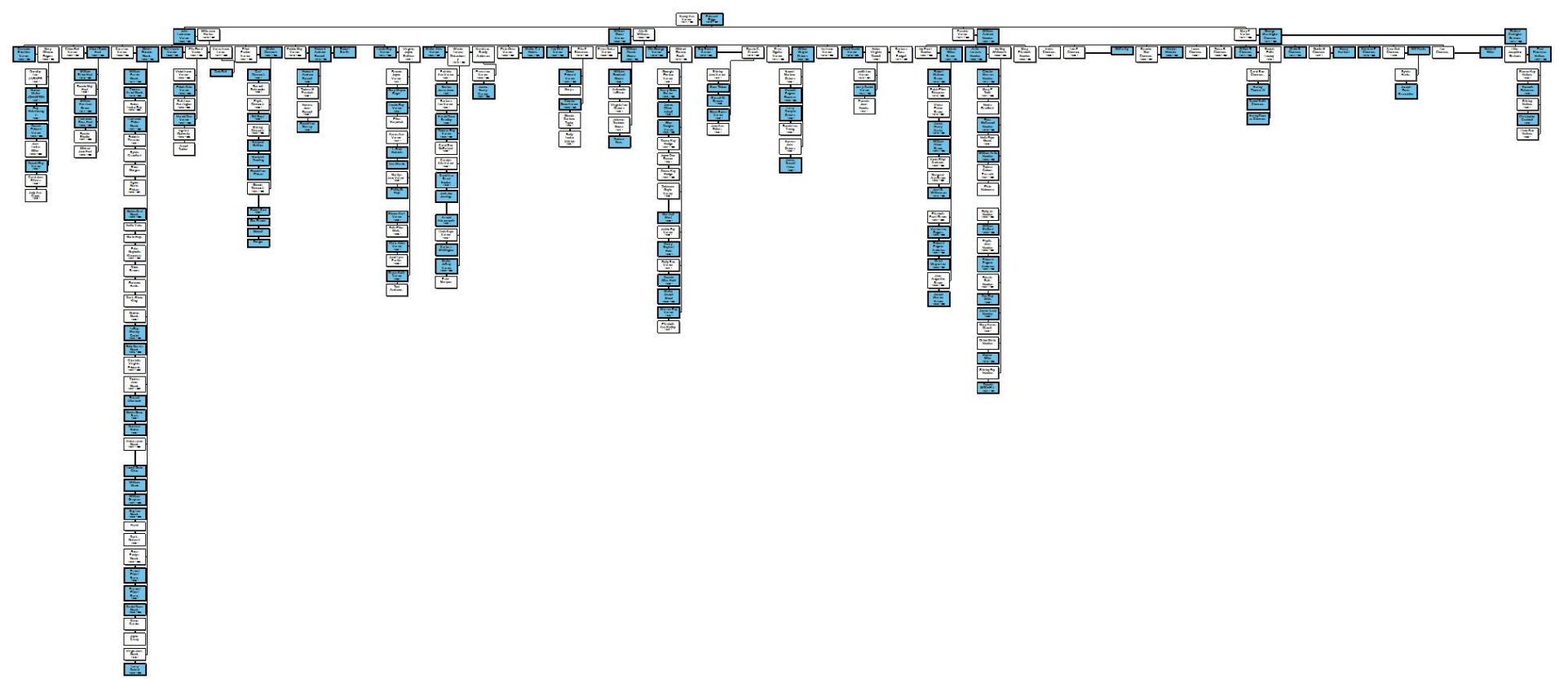

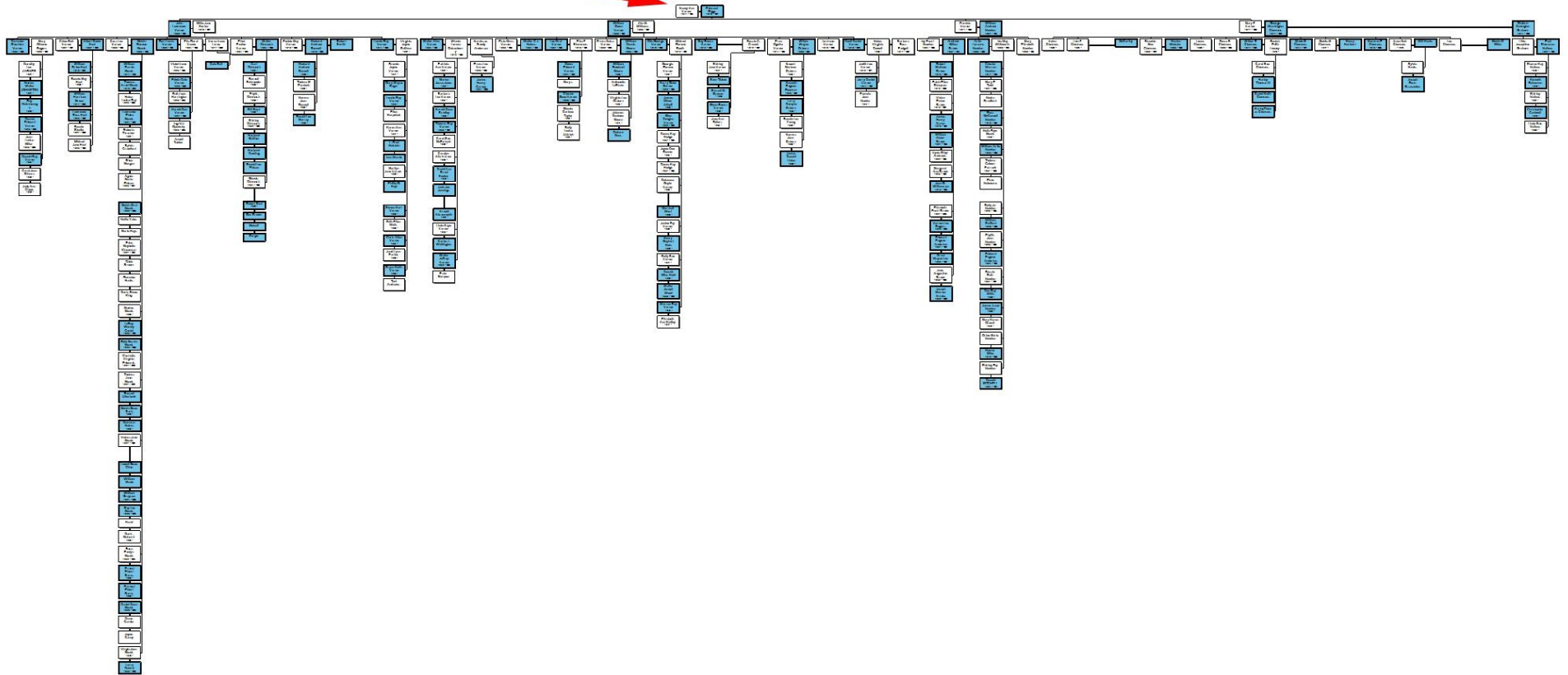
Not meant to be viewed for details, this is an overview of a three generation chart with Nancy Ann Varner at the top and the last shown generation at the bottom seen vertically.

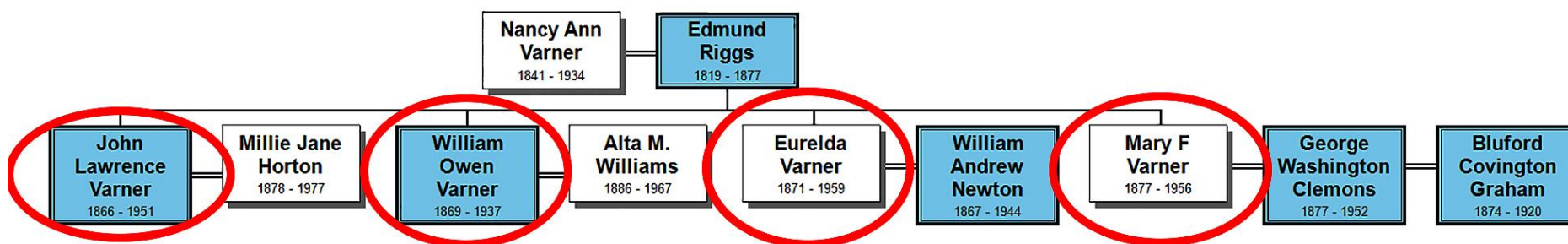

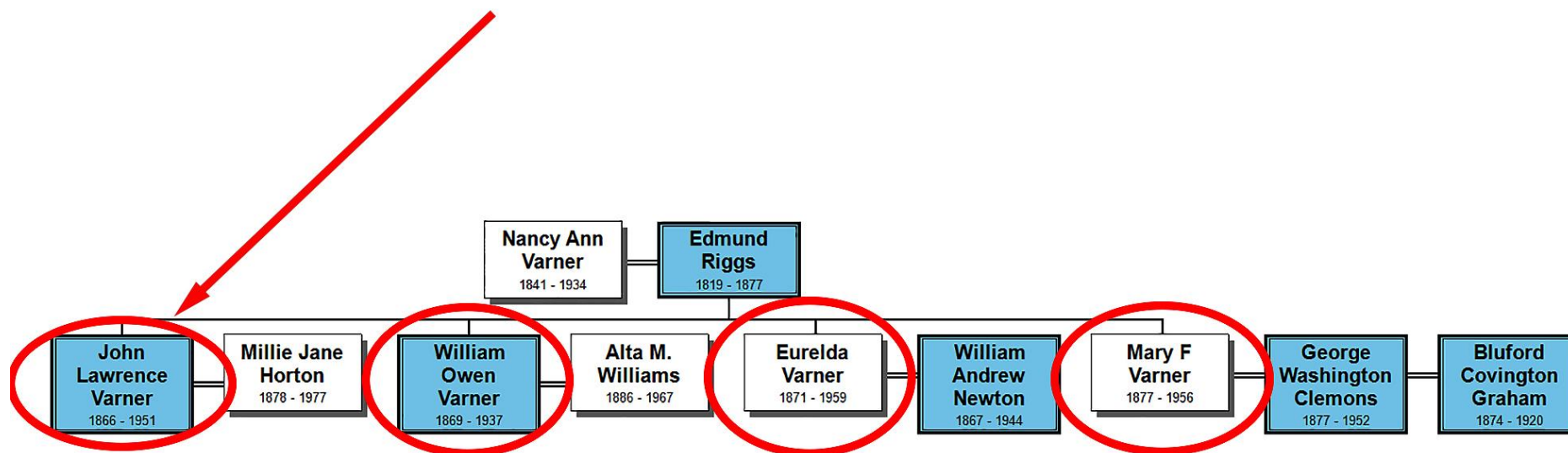

This becomes important when you deal in Autosomal DNA results as those are the surnames that in your line, you would descend from and therefore likely carry their Autosomal DNA as a result. Some of the lines may not include the surnames that married into the family of some individuals if I do not have that information.

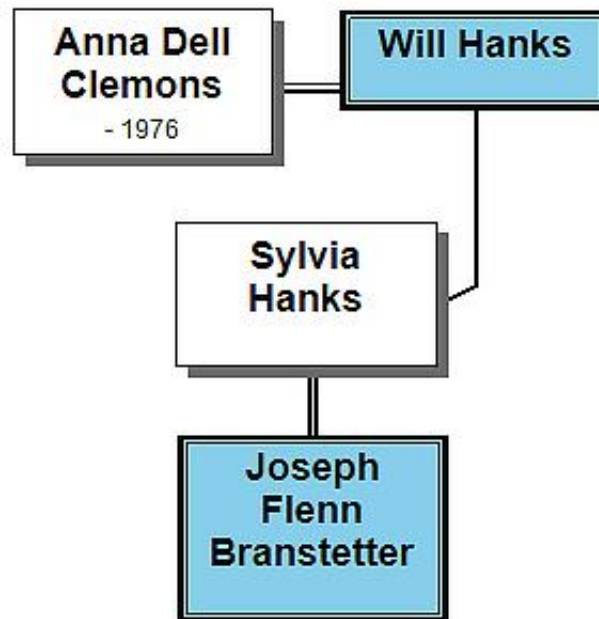


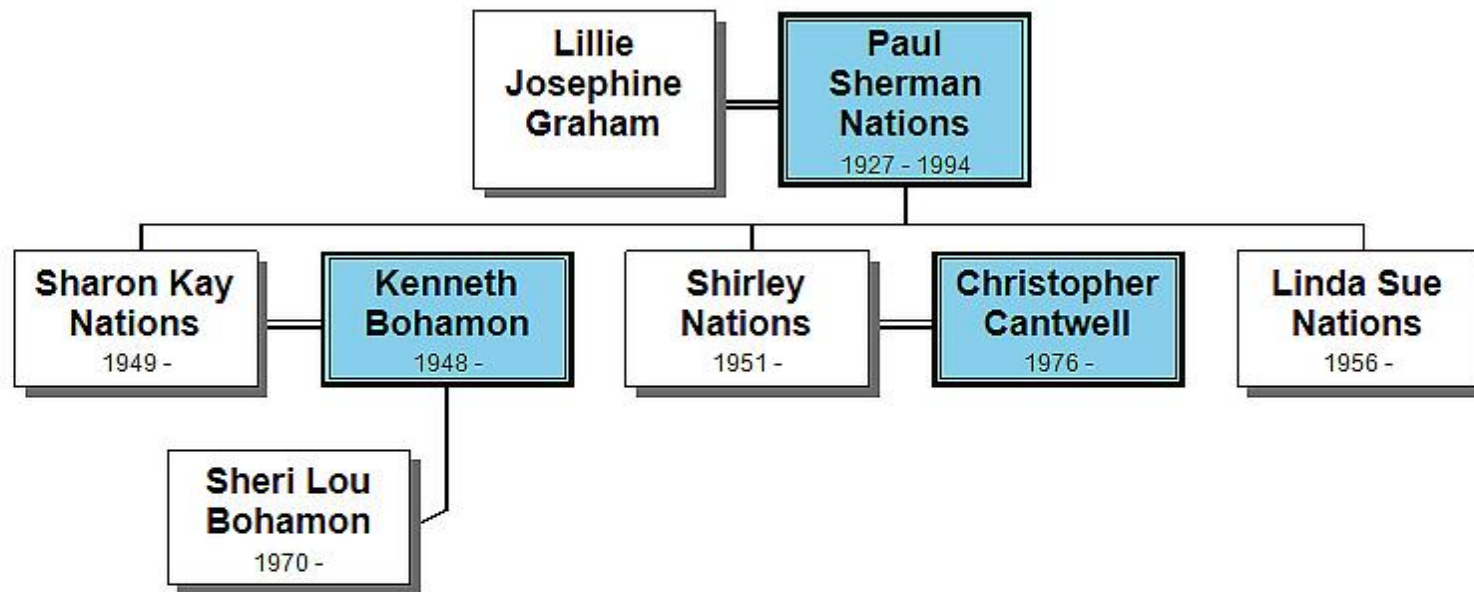


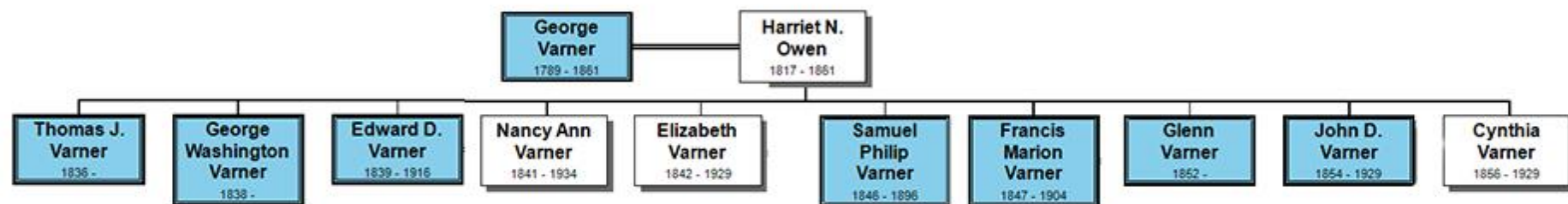








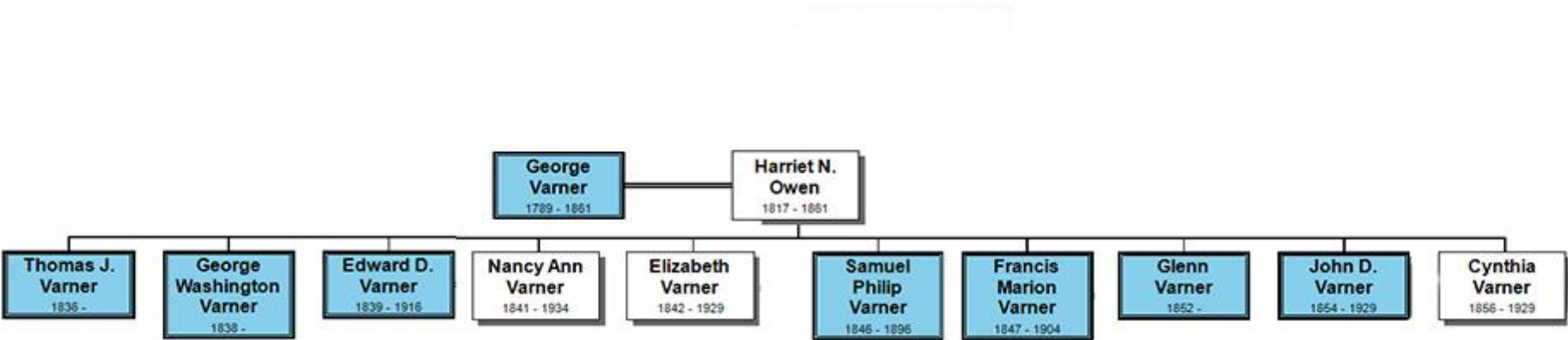




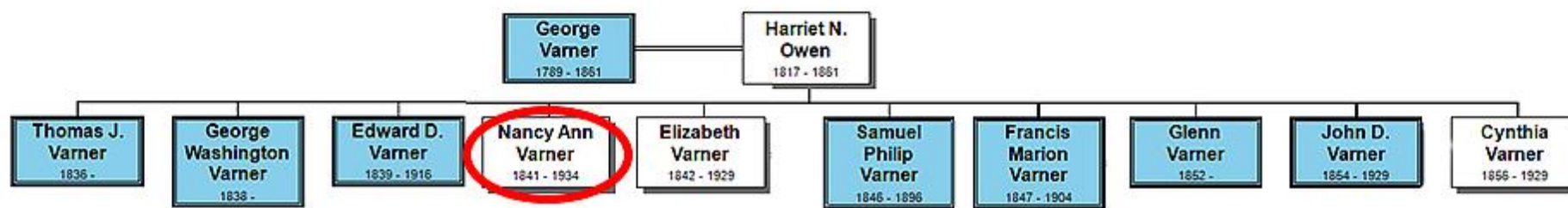
- **The Varner Common Ancestor: Billy Joe & William Virgil**
 - Suggestions on methods to help determine.



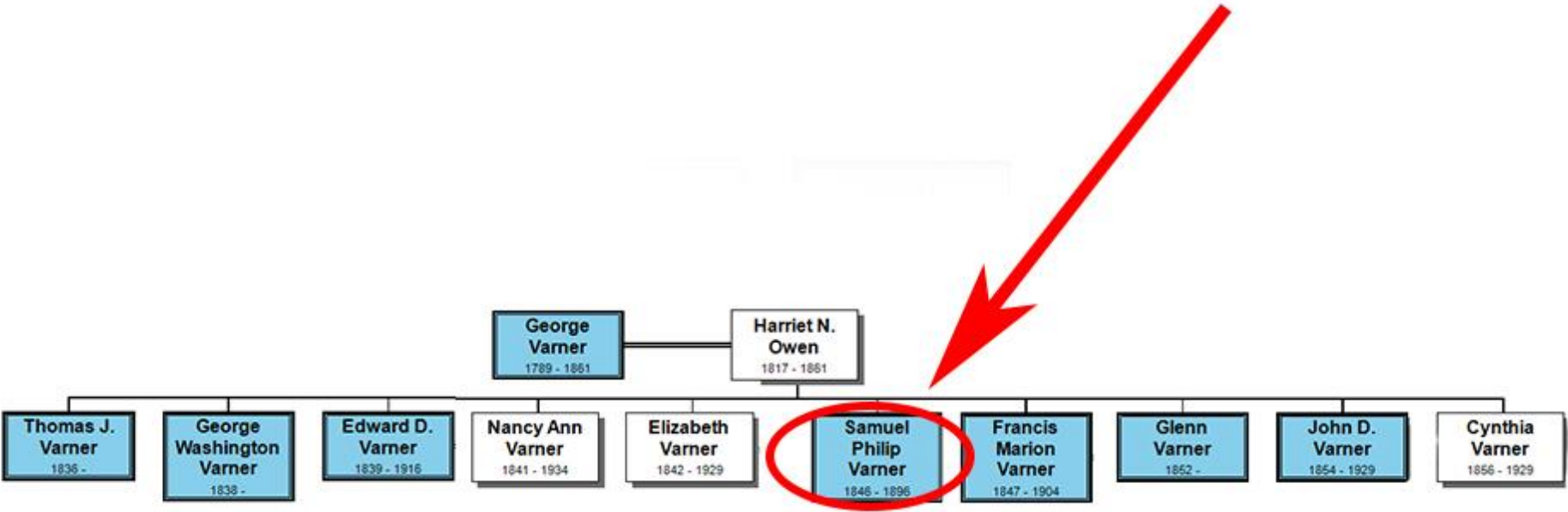
Below we discussed ancestors of Billy Joe Varner (Descendant of Samuel Philip Varner) & William Virgil Varner (A One Deviation Match to Billy Joe). We are yet to discover Most Resent Common Ancestor so let's go over what we know, to help us in our search for this link.

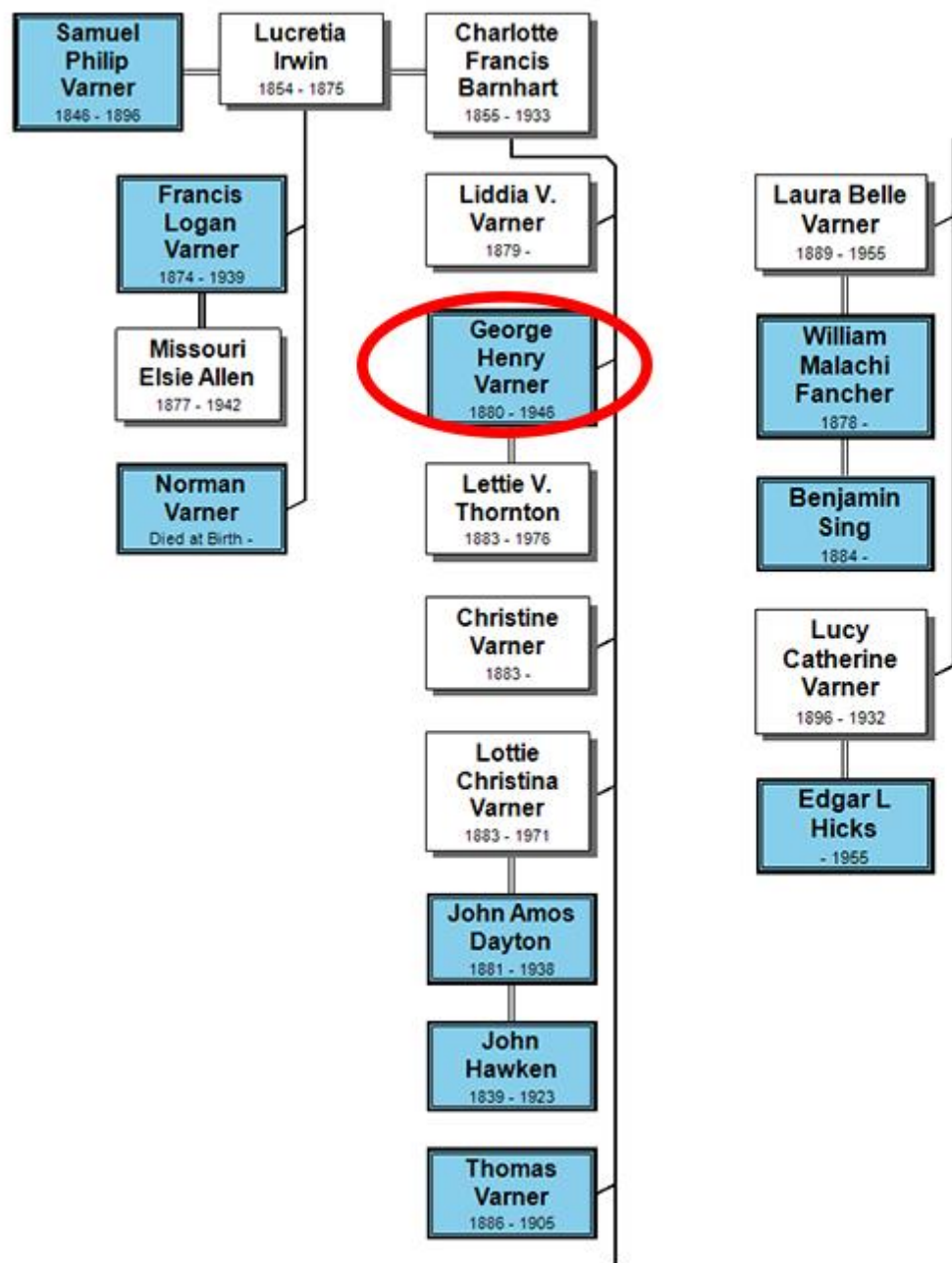


Our Camden County Varner line comes through Nancy Ann Varner. This means that those descendants are truly Y-DNA Riggs, not Varner's.



However, those males descended from Nancy Ann's brothers would be true genetic Varner's. Such as Billy Joe Varner, a Samuel Philip Varner descendant, whom was tested.

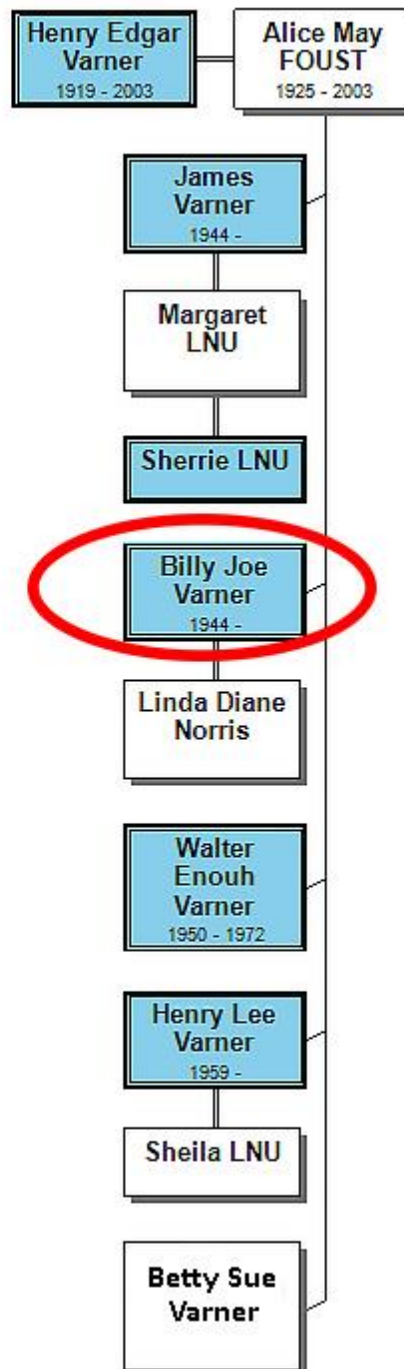

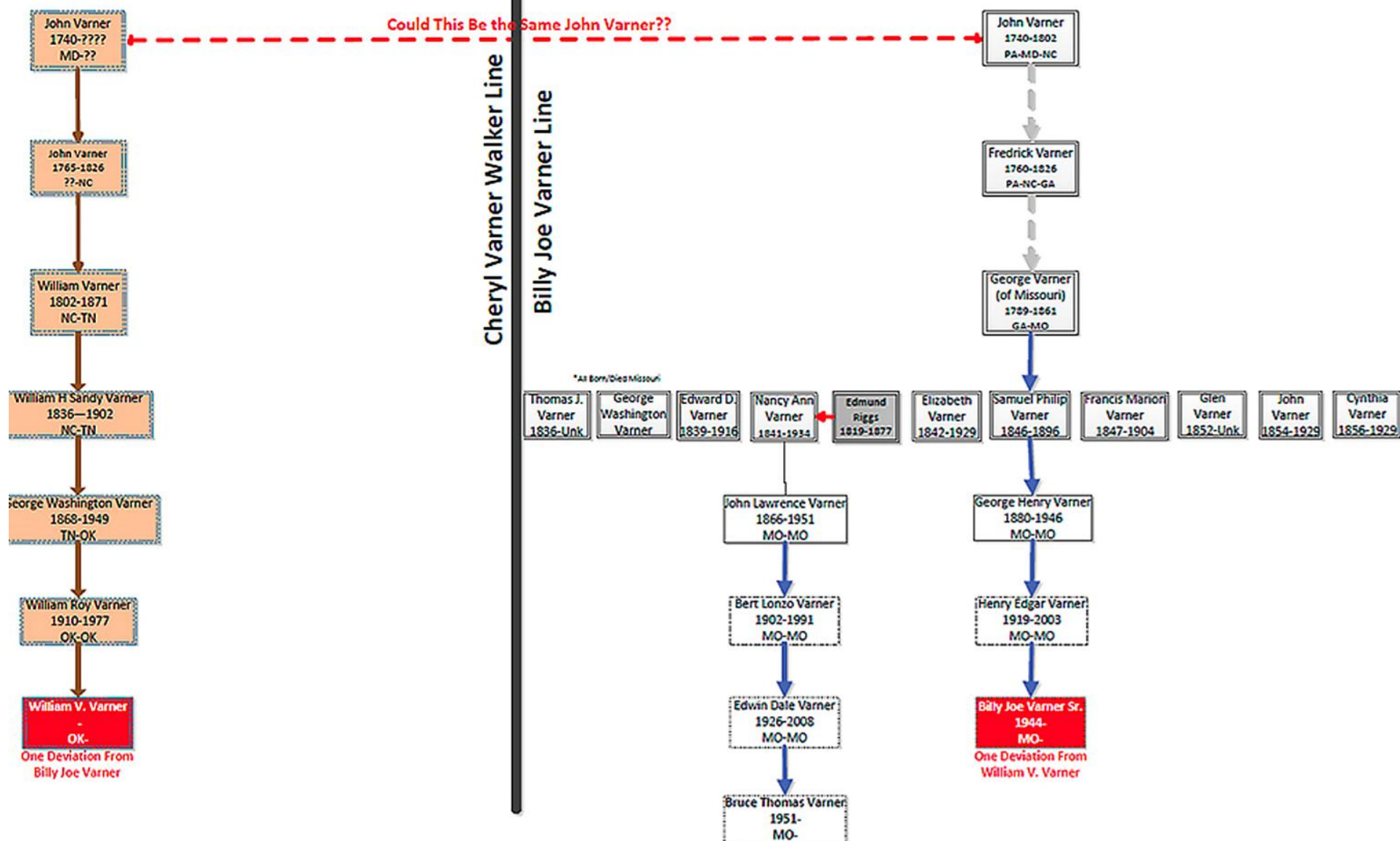

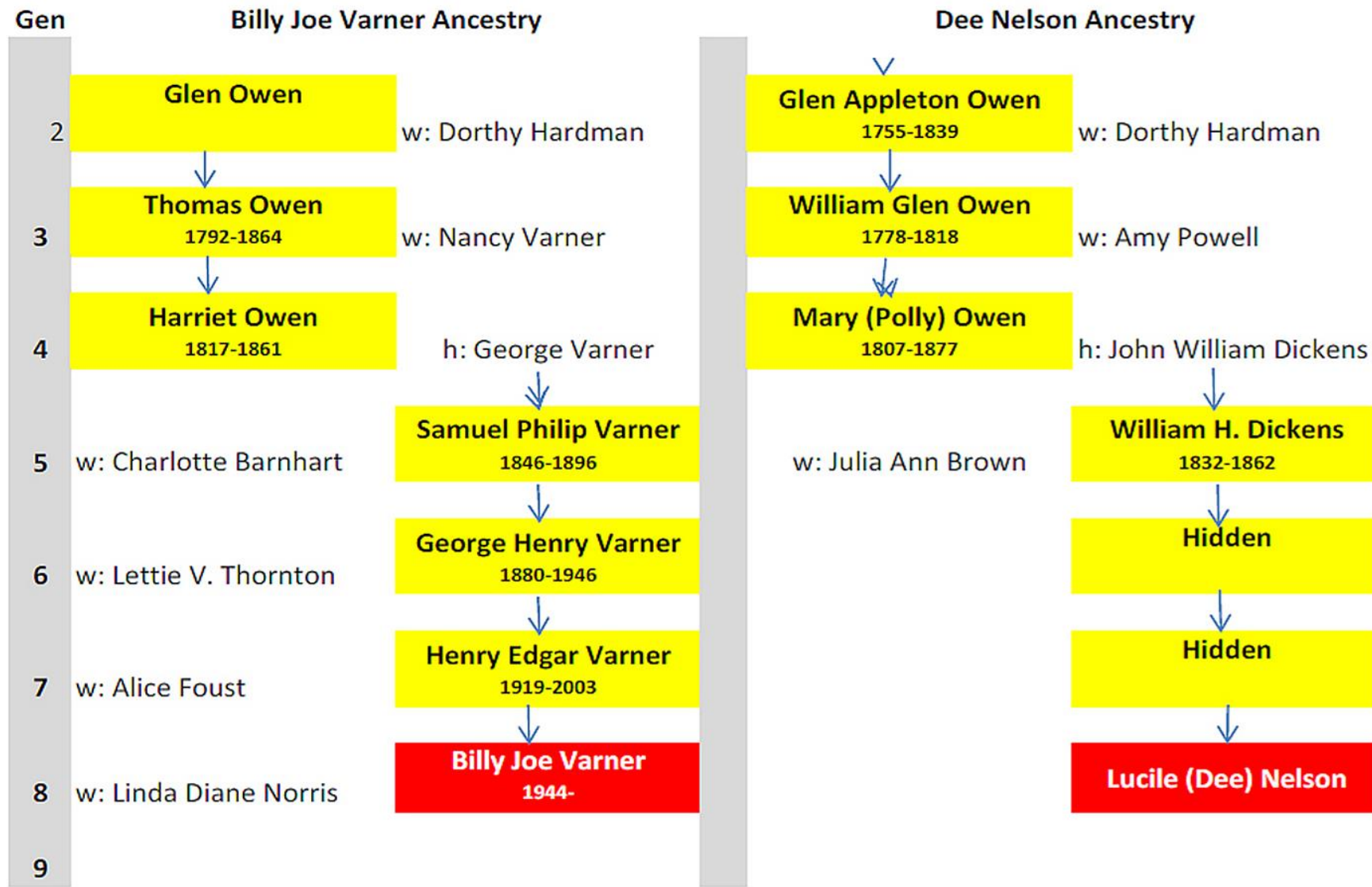

Example 1: Comparision of Autosomal DNA between Bruce Varner & Dee Anne Hunt Bremer. Meant to show how Autosmoal DNA works its way back through generations through both male and femail ancestors. Also shows how the DNA companies make suggested possible cousin matches. John Lawrence Varner is our common ancestor, making us 2nd cousins.

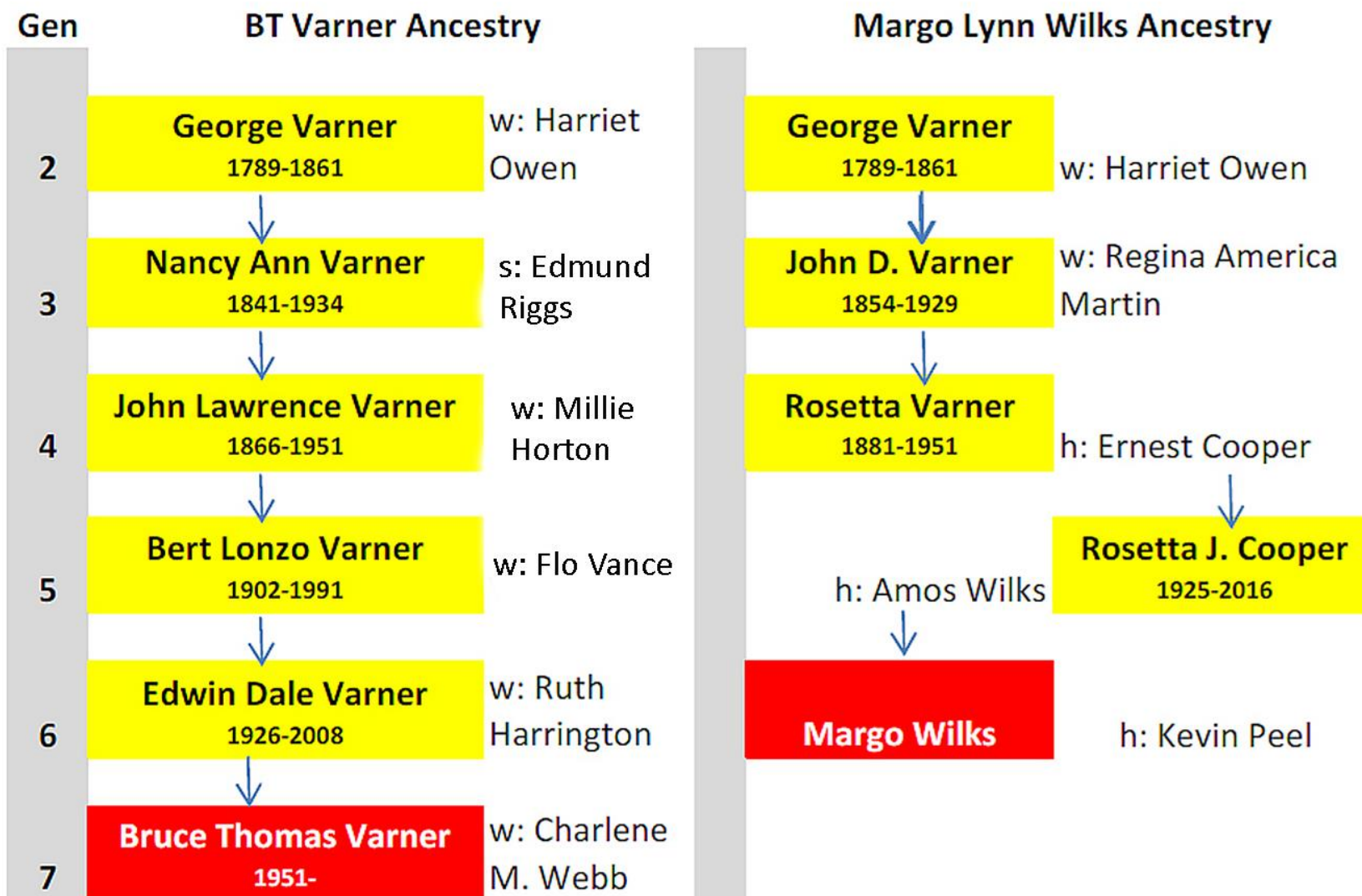

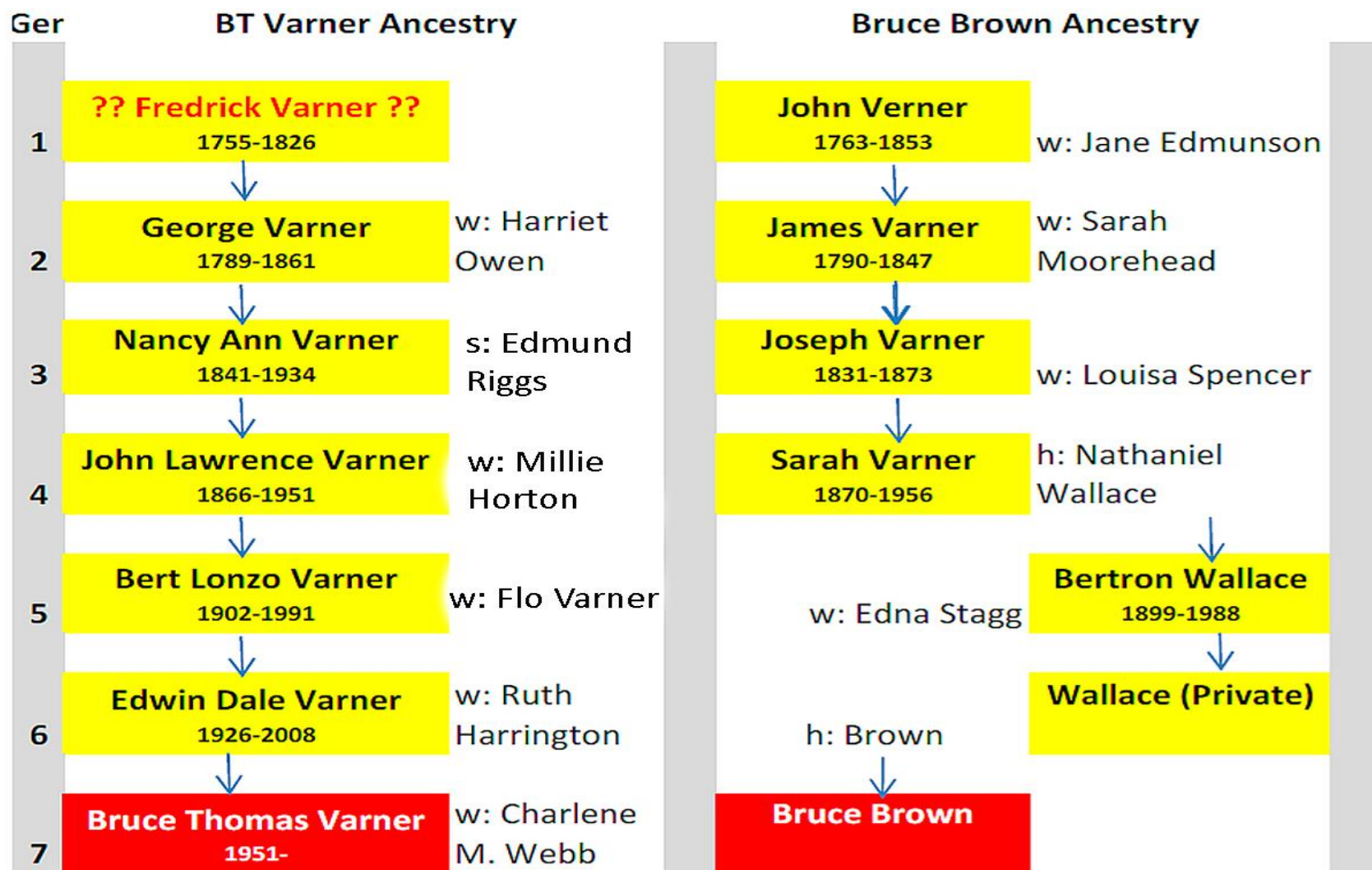
Example 2: Comparison of Autosomal DNA between Billy Joe Varner & a Dee Nelson. Made via a 5th to remote cousin possible match in FamilyTree DNA. Shows that even remote chance Autosomal matches can produce results. This match is at a 5th cousin level. Something that would not have likely been followed up, because of the low probability of a provable match, if not for filtering via the Owen surname.



Example 3: Comparison of Autosomal DNA between Bruce Varner & a Margo Wilks. Made via a 5th to remote cousin possible match in FamilyTree DNA. Another showing that remote chance Autosomal matches can produce results. This match is at a 3rd cousin, once removed level. Another unlikely to have been followed up, because of the low probability of a provable match, if not for filtering via the Varner surname.

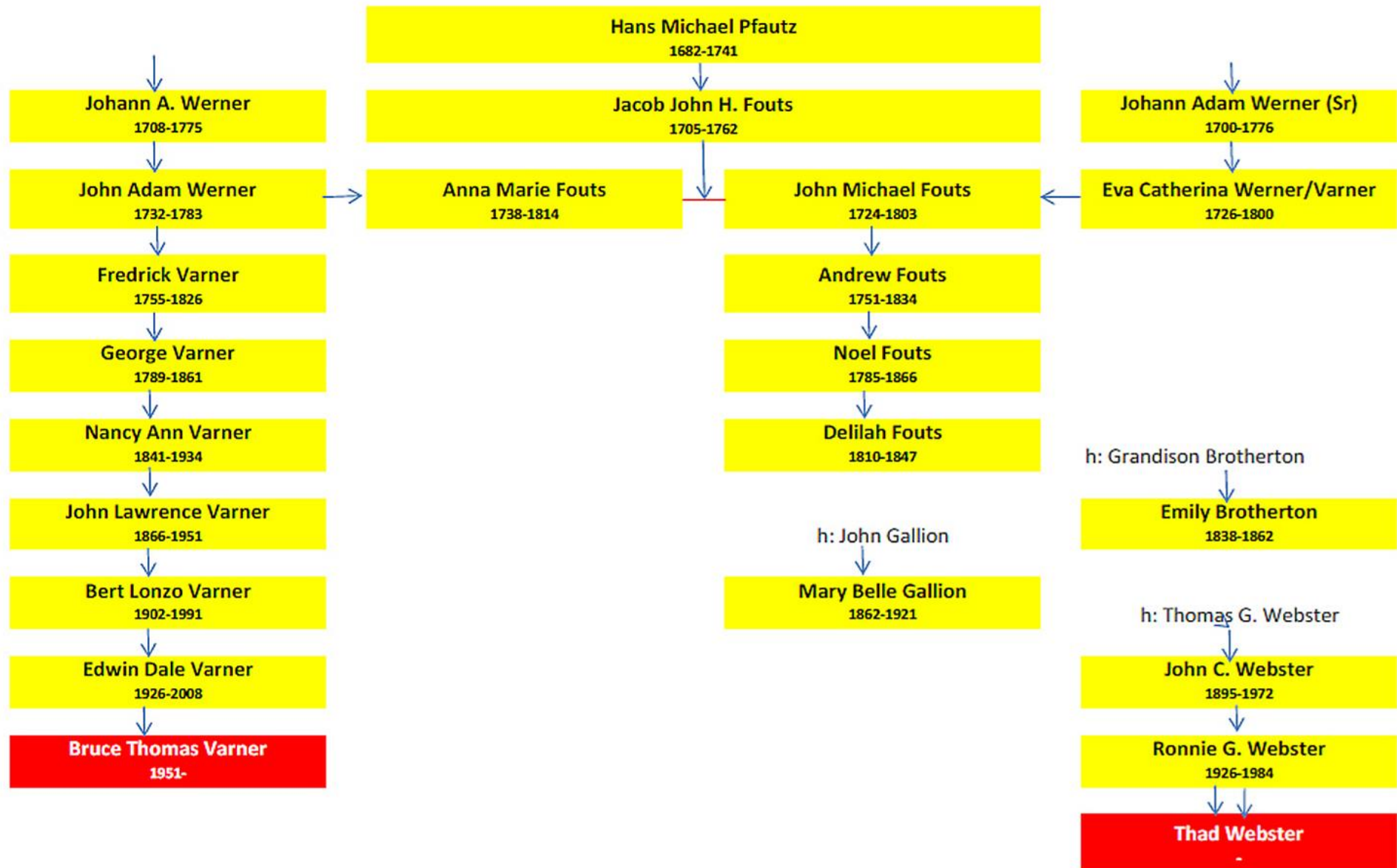


Example 4: Comparison of Autosomal DNA between Bruce Varner & a Dr. Bruce Brown. Made via a 5th to remote cousin possible match in FamilyTree DNA. Also showing a remote result. The actual match here is not resolved, but provides a stepping stone for future use in proving or disproving theories. Yet another unlikely, low probability match. Filtered again on the Varner surname.

Example 5: Final comparison between Bruce Varner & a Thad Webster. Made via a 5th to remote cousin possible match in FamilyTree DNA. The match is here, but is open for debate and further research to finally resolve. Filtered on the Varner surname. The use of Autosomal DNA testing is increasing at light speed and the possibilities are great! Everyone, I mean everyone should be submitting for Autosomal DNA because of the assistance it can provide.....
