



Adam Varner appeared in Rowan Co. by 1762




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
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
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


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
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
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
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
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
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


Early North Carolina Varner's, 1st Documented in NC.

Adam Varner listed in Randolph Co. (Old Rowan) by 1779.




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
William Varner in Lincoln Co. by 1785



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


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
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
Matthew Varner recorded in Rowan Co. by 1779

In 1802 William Varner was born in Rowan Co.


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This William Varner is the son of the earlier John Varner in Rowan, then Davidson Counties.



Which means the MRCA is 50% likely <u>not</u> to have occurred between the years of 1703 & 1748. This would have been before Varner settlement in NC.

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Flip a coin. "On average" a coin lands heads 50% of the time. If you flip a coin 10 times it likely not turn out to be half and half. It COULD even be heads all 10 times! But flip a coin 1000 times & it likely will be close to 50/50. This is what makes predicting generations a gamble.

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FamilyTree DNA says: At Y-67 level, with a 3 or 4 deviation, if two men share a surname, they likely have a MRCA within genealogical timeframe, if the deviations occur in several of the fast mutating genes. Our deviations between William Virgil & Billy Joe do <u>NOT</u> occur within those genes. Rather they occur to other, slow mutating genes.

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
This does not preclude that our families beat the odds, or that two already diverged ancestors lived in early NC at the same time, just that the MRCA just as likely did not occur in NC.




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


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


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




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Correction To The Slideshow Presented At The Reunion!!


John Varner of Rowan Co. NC.

- Wife name unknown
- Died abt. 1800 in Rowan Co. with no will
- Settled in Rowan Co. along the Yadkin River
- Father to John Varner, Jacob Varner, & Matthew Varner of Rowan/Davidson Counties
- John Varner is the G-G-G grandfather of William Virgil Varner
- George, Fredrick, & Henry are possible children of this John Varner



John Varner of Rowan/Davidson Co. NC.

- Son of John Varner who dies abt. 1800 in Rowan Co.
- Owned his father's same land.
- Became Davidson Co. in 1822
- Wife Rebecca Davis
- Will signed 16th Feb. 1826
- Will proven Sep. 1827
- William Varner is the G-G grandfather of William Virgil Varner
- Therefore, our lines G


